2018 Climate, Safety, and Wellness Survey

Dear Meadow Point Parents/Guardians,

As part of Cherry Creek School District's ongoing efforts to provide safe, supportive learning environments for students and create effective partnerships among students, families, and school staff, during the months of November and December we will survey students, parents, and staff about the climate of safety, wellness, and support

that exists in our schools. Having information that comes directly from students, parents, and staff is a critical part of making sure that schools are safe and inclusive for all children.

All parents will be invited to complete the survey in an email that will be sent in October.

Third through fifth grade students and a random sample of middle and high school students will be asked to complete the survey. If you have a child who is asked to take part in the survey, the email from the district will include additional information about the student survey, including what to do if you don't want your child to participate. The student survey will also be posted on the district's website for parents to review.

The information from the surveys is important for safety and prevention planning both at the district and school levels. All schools will be given summary reports of their school's data in Spring 2019.
